

About the College

Midnapore College (Autonomous) is situated in the heart of the historic town of Midnapore. the college established in 1873 has already completed 147 years of its glorious existence. It presently affiliated to the Vidyasagar University, Paschim Medinipur. Midnapore College is now imparting education in 22 Honours courses in U.G, 14 Post Graduation courses and 02 general courses in morning and day shifts under CBCS and semester system along with different diploma and certificate courses.
