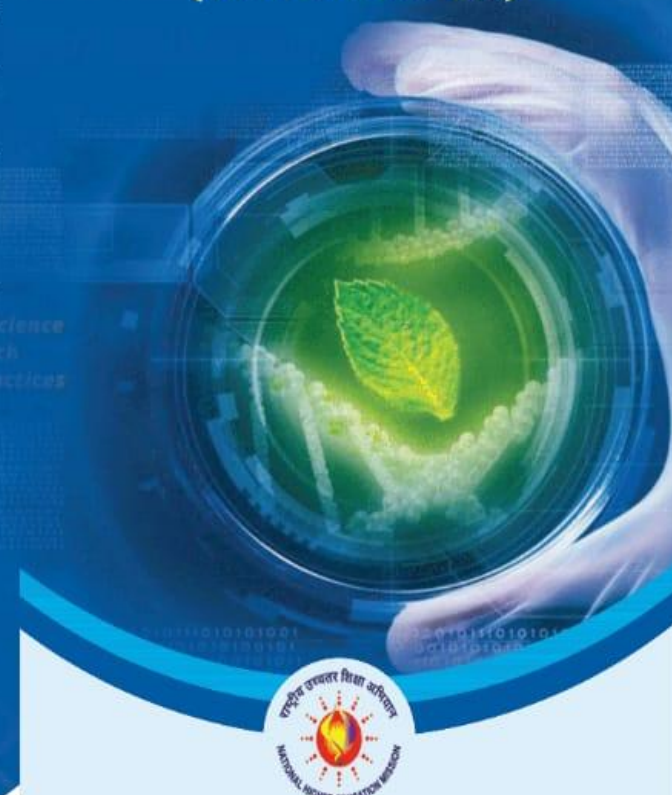

HOW TO REACH MIDNAPORE

Midnapore College (Autonomous) is situated in the Heart of the Midnapore City. The College is about 2 KM from the midnapore Railway Station and 1 km from Central Bus Stand. INSTRUCTION TO AUTHORS

The title should be in 14 font Times New Roman and Bold. The name of author(s) should be in 12 font Times New Roman, typed in capital letters, one space below the title and should be centralized. Mark an asterisk on the name or corresponding author/presenter. Name of the organization shall come below the name of the author (s) including its postal address with pin code and E-mail. The abstract(s) should not contain more than 300 words typed in 12 font Times New Roman in 1.5 line spacing. Theme should be mentioned on the top of the page.

Full Paper will be published in the book form with ISBN and that should be submitted on or before 02.03.2020.

Guidelines for submission of Full Paper : Authors are requested to submit their papers as per the style and font of 'Current Science', Current Science Association of the Indian Academy of Science, Bangalore, India.

POSTER : Poster Size should be 120cm (Height) x 90cm (Width) with abstract, objective, materials and method, observation/ result, discussion and conclusion, references, table, figure, chart etc.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

All abstracts are to be submitted only through E-mail at nsrapsbmc2020@gmail.com in Microsoft word file format or .doc or .docx along with scanned copy of registration slip. Submitted abstracts will be peer reviewed and only selected ones will be allowed for the oral presentation and the rest will be considered for Poster Presentation. Abstracts will be published in the Book of Abstracts/ Proceedings of the said Seminar.
